



Dress Code

Club Matches

When playing against other clubs, members should wear the green club polo shirt.

The colour of trousers and/or skirts depends on the fixture. Consult the fixture list for guidance. Ladies can wear either skirts or trousers.

Bowls shoes (white, grey or brown) or training shoes should always be worn.

Club Competitions

When playing in a club competition against other members, the dress code is more relaxed. Players can wear either normal bowls wear or smart casual wear. The only exception is on finals weekend when white trousers or skirts should be worn with either the green club polo shirt or white equivalent.

Bowls shoes (white, grey or brown) or training shoes should always be worn.

County Competitions

When playing in a County competition, members should wear the green club polo shirt and grey trousers or skirt. Ladies can wear either skirts or trousers.

Bowls shoes (white, grey or brown) or training shoes should always be worn.

Roll-Ups & The Monday Night League

The dress code for roll-ups and the Monday Night League is altogether more relaxed. Members can wear either normal bowls wear or smart casual dress.
