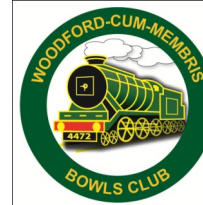

### Please remember...

- The green will require different treatments throughout the year and there is a list of full duties assigned to each month on the back of the green keeping shed door. For the 2011 season, these will be administered by Tom and Paul.
- For the 2011 season only, Tom and Paul will also be responsible for watering the green (unless otherwise agreed).
- Ken Barber also has access to the club, so if you find a strange man doing something to the green — don't worry!
- Work can be carried out on any day of the week but please bear in mind that there may be matches on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays, so keep a close eye on the fixture list.
- Always check the height of the mower blades against the chart on the inside of the shed door.
- The green should always be cut diagonally, in opposite directions (from the gate or water tank) on alternate weeks.
- Always make a note in the green folder (kept in the clubhouse) of the duties you've carried out during your week such as from which end you cut the green. Also record any observations you have about the condition of the green.
- Please ensure that at the end of your week the mower's tank is full of unleaded petrol. Fill the green can and give your receipt to Brian for reimbursement.
- Please remove all debris from the green ditches.
- Only put organic matter from the green into the compost bays.
- Keep an eye on the length of the grass surrounds and mow if they need cutting.
- Please empty all grass cuttings into the brown bins.
- Dean Broughton, a turfcare contractor, will be visiting the club to aerate the green every month for the remainder of the year.
- Lastly, if for any reason you're unable to attend to the green on a given date, please make sure that you swap with another member of the team.
